General stipulations for PhDopgrammes are provided in the

For a degree of Licentiate the research students must have received a pass grade on a scholarly dissertation of at least 60 ECTS ctedi

For a degree of Doctor the research students must have received a pass grade on a doctoral dissertation of at least 150 ECTS credits.

3. Admission Requirements

Applicants to doctoral studies must meet the general admission requirements as well as the specific admission requirements and be judged to have the ability otherwise required to pursue the programme successfully I(ligher Education @dinance Ch.7, § 35).

4. Admission Procedure

Applications for admission to doctoral studies are processed in accordance with the procedures prescribed by the Board of Karlstad University.

Candidates will be selected on the basis of their assessed capacity to successfully complete a programme at the doctoral level. In the ranking and selection of the candidates, special atilention w be paid to the proposed research area, supervision capacity and to the candidates' intention to be present and participate in the research environment.
