Literature in English outside the US, the Twentieth Century

## **Higher Education Credits**

7.5

#### **Course Content**

The course is by and large based on reading individually selected literary texts, thus s to some extent. In addition to the primary texts, appropriate parts of a work providing an overview of literary history shall be read, as well as at least three works of criticism or theory connected to the time period, and selected in consultation with the examiner.

A series of seminars on selected primary texts from the reading list complements individual reading. Participants are expected to be well prepared for seminars, and to actively participate in discussions.

Assessment takes the form of continuous assessment and an individual written essay.

One of the grades Fail (U) or Pass (G) is awarded in the examination of the course.
